SCHOOL ATTIRE AND PUNCTUALITY

2. All students are reminded to look neat and smart when wearing their school uniform. Shirts (including PE shirt) must be tucked in neatly at all times. **They must also have their name tags on their school uniform and PE attire.**

3. All students are expected to be in school **by 7.25 a.m.** for our flag raising assembly. In Term 1, we still noticed students either being dropped off by parents at the foyer or walking into the school only at or after 7.30 a.m. We seek all parents' cooperation in emphasising the importance of punctuality to your children. Please note that School Leaders will be reaching out to engage parents of students who have been late persistently despite reminders.

STUDENTS WHO ARE UNWELL

4. Safeguarding the health and well-being of our students is our collective responsibility. We seek your cooperation in taking your child/ward to see a doctor if he/she is unwell, especially when he/she develops flu-like symptoms such as fever or vomiting. When advised by the doctor, students should stay home when they have these symptoms to prevent the spread of illness.

5. In the event that your child is already in school and becomes unwell during curriculum hours, we will contact you to take your child home from school as he/she may need medical attention. To ensure we can reach you promptly, please save the school's contact number **(6269 7410)** and keep your contact details updated with the school. If we cannot reach you, we will contact your listed emergency contact.

6. There have been instances when students were very unwell, but parents were unable to pick them from school. For your child's well-being, we seek your support to ensure that your listed emergency contact can help you pick your child from school in the event that you are not able to. This will enable your child to get the necessary medical attention early, instead of remaining in the sick bay for a prolonged period of time.
