We hope you had a wonderful time bonding with your children over the June holidays. The school is excited to welcome your children back and we look forward to the continued partnership with you in the development of your children.

### WDP GOLDEN JUBILEE CARNIVAL (4 JUL 2026, Saturday)

1. As earlier shared, our school will be celebrating its 50th anniversary this year! The theme for our WDP Golden Jubilee (WDP50) is "**Anchoring our Roots and Spreading our Wings**", reflecting the school's strong foundation and values built over 50 years, as well as our continued aspirations for growth. As the culminating highlight of this celebration, we will be holding a carnival on **4 July 2026 (Saturday), from 9.00am to 1.30pm**, in the school compound. There will be games, performances, carnival delicacies and our WDP 50-year heritage exhibition. We welcome all students, parents, staff and alumni to join us.



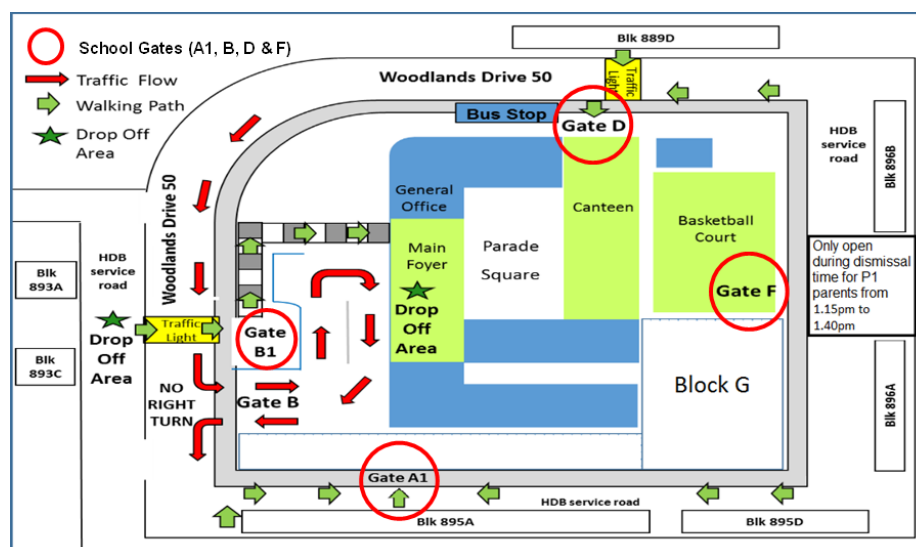
2. Please also note that Home-Based Learning (HBL) will take place for all P1–P6 students on **3 July (Fri)**. Students are not required to report to school on that day and will be assigned work. We encourage students to plan their learning fruitfully. However, some students may be involved in carnival preparations on that day. For these students, a separate consent form will be issued by the respective teacher-in-charge.

## COMPLETION OF THE SHELTERED LINKWAY

3. We are pleased to inform you that the works at the sheltered linkway with the new Security post have been completed. **With effect from 26 June 2026 (Fri)**, all students, parents and visitors **can now use Gate B1**, which is just after the traffic light across the HDB Blocks 893C. Please note that the temporary Gate B2 will now be closed.
4. With the opening of Gate B1, students, parents and visitors can now enter the school via the sheltered linkway, which provides shelter from the weather and helps reduce overcrowding at the waiting area during arrival and dismissal on rainy days.



5. Gentle reminder of the traffic management in the school (see diagram below):
  - **Arrival time:** For parents who drive into the school in the morning, we seek your understanding and cooperation to **get your child ready to alight safely and quickly at the drop-off points at the foyer**. This is in consideration of other parents/drivers and to avoid congestion both within the school as well as at the road along Woodlands Drive 50. Thank you to all parents and drivers who have been considerate and patient when driving your child into the school.
  - **Dismissal time:** For parents who drive to pick up your child at the main foyer, please note that you can drive into the school only after 1.45pm. **Please also note that Vehicle Gate B will continue to be closed from 1.25pm - 1.45pm** to better manage road safety within the school during dismissal time. Your child should be prepared for quick pick-up to avoid congestion.



## GENTLE REMINDER ON PUNCTUALITY AND SCHOOL ATTIRE

6. **Punctuality:** All students are expected to be in school by 7.25 a.m., so that they can be ready for our flag raising assembly. Being punctual demonstrates personal responsibility and sets a positive tone for the day. We have noticed that there is a group of students who still enter the school only after 7.25am. While we have spoken to students on the importance of punctuality, we seek the help of parents in reinforcing this message.
7. **School attire:** All students are reminded to wear their school uniform neatly and smartly at all times. Shirts (including PE shirt) must be tucked in neatly at all times. They must also have their name tags on their school uniform and PE attire. There is still a group of students who do not have their name tags on. We seek parents' cooperation to order the name tags from the bookshop as soon as possible.
