Dear Parents / Guardians,

We hope you have had quality time bonding with your children over the school term break. The school is excited to welcome our students back and we look forward to working closely with you in their development.

PSLE AND HOME-BASED LEARNING

- The school will be implementing a study break for our P6 students in the lead up to the PSLE written examination from **22 Sep (Mon) to 24 Sep (Wed)**. **P6 students are not required to report to school during these three days**. All other students from P1 – P5 will report to school as usual.
- The PSLE written examination will take place from **25 Sep (Thu) to 1 Oct (Wed)**. P6 students are required to refer to the PSLE Information Booklet and report to school punctually for the respective papers that they are sitting for. The school wishes all our P6 students the very best for their upcoming PSLE.
- Home-Based Learning (HBL) will take place for **P3 and P4 levels** during the PSLE written examination days. Students on HBL are not required to report to school on their respective HBL days. They will be assigned work and are advised to plan their learning fruitfully. Students from all other levels are required to report to school as per normal.

P5 OUTDOOR ADVENTURE CAMP 2025 (29 Sep – 1 Oct)

- The P5 students will be going for their P5 overnight camp at MOE Changi Coast Outdoor Adventure Learning Centre (CCOALC) from **29 Sep to 1 Oct (Mon – Wed)**. Students will first assemble in school on 29 Sep (Mon) before proceeding to the campsite in their classes. Please refer to the P5 Camp Letter dated 29 July 2025 which we have sent out to all P5 parents for more details.

CHILDREN'S DAY CELEBRATION (2 Oct)

6. The school will celebrate Children's Day on **2 Oct (Thu) from 7.30am to 10.30am**. This year's theme is "Time Travellers' Playground: Reminiscing the Past, Relishing the Present", which encourages students to understand the past as they embrace the future with curiosity, creativity, and exploration. In keeping with our time travel theme, students are encouraged to dress in traditional costumes or attire that represents the past. Kindly ensure that all costumes are appropriate for school. Students can also come in their usual school attire – school PE attire with school shorts/skirt, school shoes and socks.
7. As there are no lessons planned on that day, students can bring along a small bag with a storybook and water bottle. Please also note that the canteen will not be opened, and you may want to ensure that your child/ward has breakfast before reporting to school. They can also bring along a light snack to consume during their meal break.
8. The staggered dismissal timing is indicated below for your reference. Kindly make the necessary transport arrangement to fetch your child.

9. Please note that Children's Day school holiday falls on **3 Oct (Fri)**, and there is no school on that day. All students will report back to school as per normal on **6 Oct (Mon)**.

PSLE MARKING DAYS (13 – 15 Oct)

10. There will be no school for the P1 to P6 levels during the PSLE Marking Days from 13 Oct (Mon) to 15 Oct 2025 (Wed). For selected students involved in specific school activities during this period, details will be issued by the respective teachers-in-charge. School will resume as usual for all students on 16 Oct (Thu).

INFRASTRUCTURE WORKS - SHELTERED LINKWAY FROM SECURITY POST TO FOYER

11. We are pleased to inform you that construction of the above sheltered linkway will take place from late November 2025 to mid-June 2026. This covered linkway will allow students and parents to be sheltered from the weather and help reduce overcrowding at the waiting area during arrival/dismissal on rainy days.
12. During construction, there will be temporary changes to the security post location, Gate B1, and vehicular traffic routes within the school. We will share more in a separate letter when the final details are confirmed.
